

Planter Inspections
Recommended Annually

The pass you make across the field with your planter is your most important pass of the year. To make a great stand even better, you've got to be running at your best. If you have a vacuum planter it means running the correct meters, at the correct speed with the proper vacuum pressure. If you have a finger pickup planter, it means the meters are calibrated and working properly. In either case keeping your planter in top shape should be an extremely high priority. A planter that delivers unnecessary skips and doubles can easily result in a yield reduction of 5 bushels to the acre or more.

We have planter experts that will place your meters on our ***Precision Planter Test Stand*** then make the required repairs and adjustments as needed. Many of our customers have their meters tested and repaired annually. The cost is minimal and the rewards can be monumental. This is how it works:
